As a country located within one of the world's most seismically active regions and historically exposed to climate-related events such as El

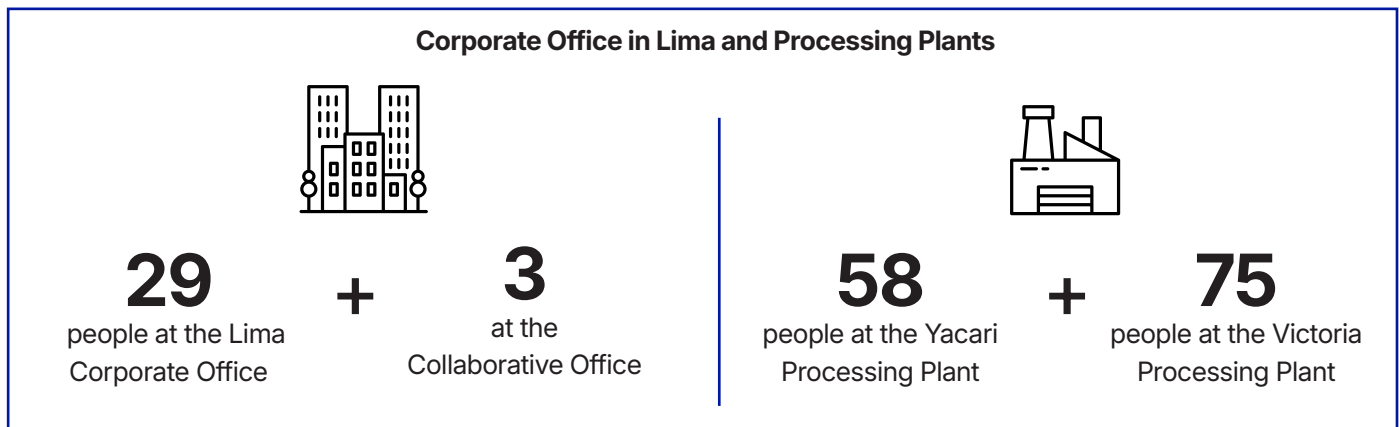
